THEME FOR THE DAY: Casually, even in just making conversation, we often say, "Stay out of trouble." But how do you define trouble and how do you stay out of it? Jesus in our Gospel reading says, "Do not let your hearts be troubled." And in our first reading Stephen seems to be in trouble as he goes before the Sanhedrin and is taken out and stoned to become the first martyr of the New Testament Church. What do we get from all this? Today we will look at what we are told in Scripture in a message entitled, "Staying Out of Trouble."
